WABASSO ISLAND, Fla. The Environmental Learning Center (ELC) will provide a one-day surfing and beach adventure called "Let's Go Surfin' Now" on June 26, 2008.

The morning surf lesson, long a part of the ELC summer camp program, will be taught by Lisa Mead ("the kids love her") of the Central Florida Surf School along with her teaching associates and Heather Stapleton, education coordinator

for the ELC, who will lead the afternoon swimming, games and beachcombing activities.

The Central Florida Surf School of Vero Beach, “one of the top 5 places to learn” and “your best bet on the East Coast” (Mens Health Magazine), uses the waves at the Fort Pierce Inlet as its classroom. The ELC event is for kids ages 12 to 16 and is targeted at beginners who want to learn the proper safety, basic techniques and skills of surfing.
