Maggy Bowman Scholarship Application 2022-2023

Maggy Bowman was a founder of Pelican Island Audubon Society, the Environmental Learning Center, and the Marine Resources Council. Throughout her lifetime Bowman was an outspoken advocate of the environment and conservation in Indian River County, a passionate birder, a proponent of quality education, a writer, a teacher, and a government official. This scholarship program was created in her honor and memory.

Scholarship recipients can receive up to 100% off of the full price of the program depending on eligibility.

This form must be completed and submitted with proof of one of the following:

- Majority of students are enrolled in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program at the school
- The school qualifies for the Title One program (Tier 1 school)*
- Majority of students' families:
 - are enrolled in the Food Assistance Program (SNAP)
 - are enrolled in the Temporary Cash Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
 Program
 - have current gross household incomes meeting federal guidelines for free or reduced price meals, refer the link below: https://www.floridahealth.gov/programs-and-services/childrens-health/child-care-food-program/documents/income-eligibility.pdf
- Any other demonstration of need (to be reviewed and determined eligible by ELC staff).
- *For school groups seeking funding that do not qualify for the Title One program, a partial scholarship may be awarded, based on the percentage of students at the school who qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch Program. The percent discount will be equal to the percentage of students enrolled in the school's Free and Reduced Lunch Program.
- **In cases of extreme financial hardship, for which the applicant cannot afford the discounted rate, ELC staff may provide a full-ride scholarship at a 100% discounted rate. Full-ride scholarships must be approved by the Executive Director.
